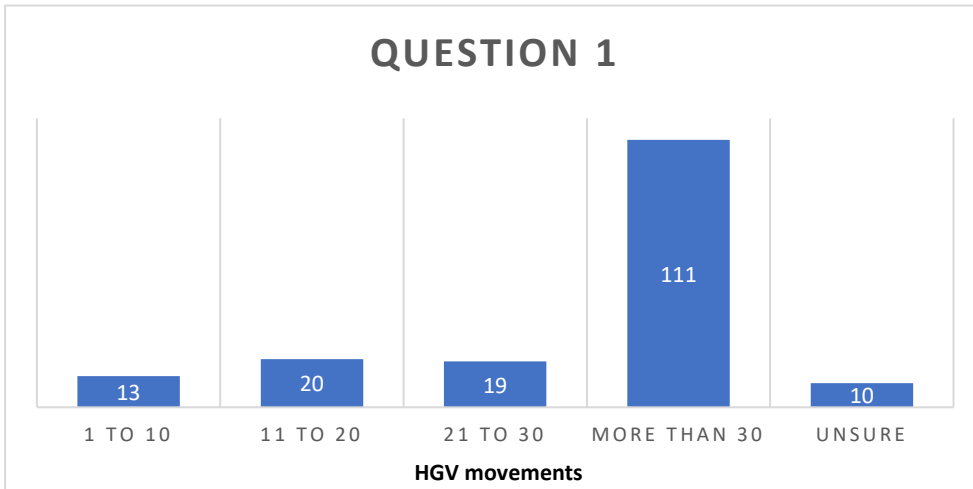




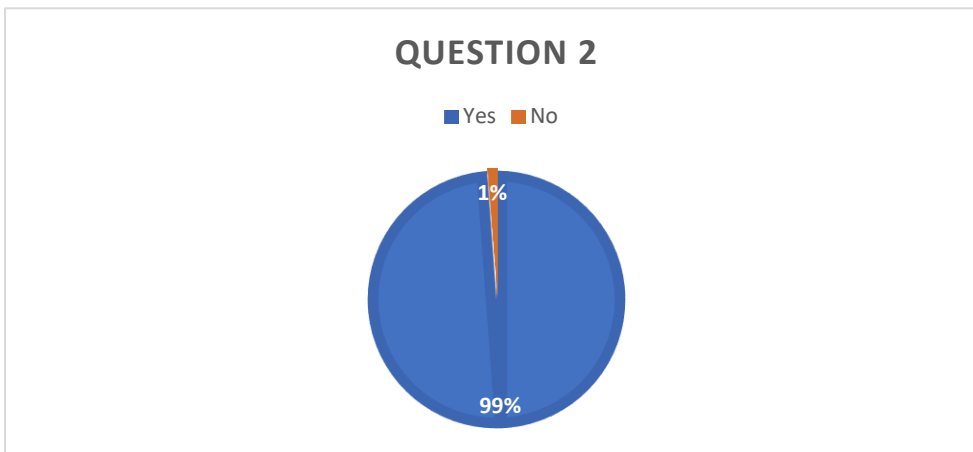
East Surrey Local Roads Survey 2020 – Burstow, Horne, Smallfield and Outwood – Data

Question 1 – How many daily HGV movements are there in the road you live/work in?



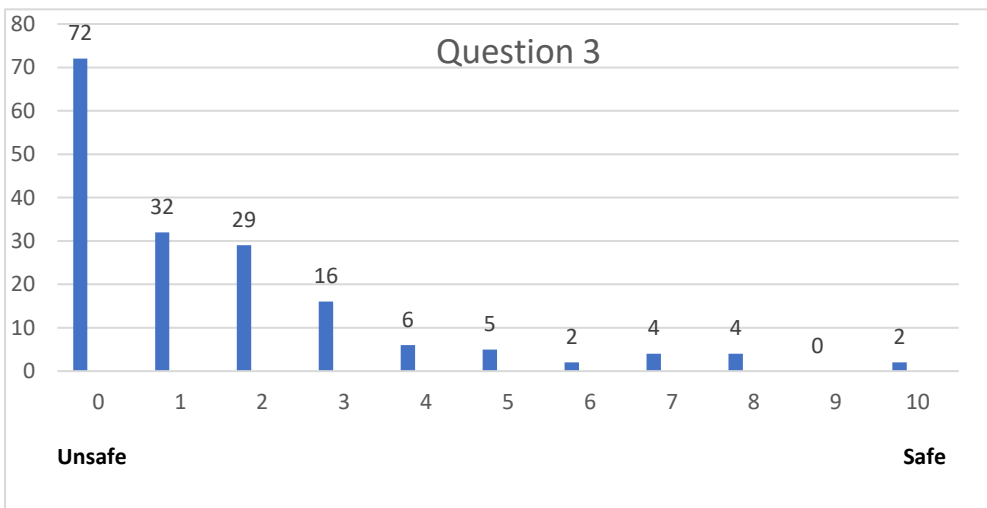
Majority of respondents reported 'More than 30' (111)

Question 2 – Have you noticed an effect that HGV movements have had on the road surface?



99% of respondents answered that local HGV movements have affected the road surface

Question 3- On a scale of 0-10 how safe do you consider your roads are for Pedestrians/Cyclists/Other Motorists?



Overall majority of respondents answered that the local roads were unsafe

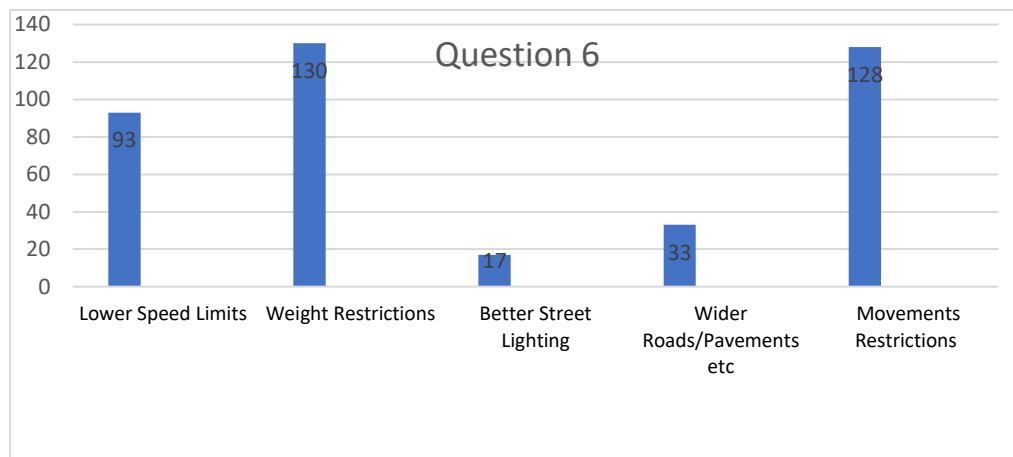
Question 4 - Has Covid-19 and lockdowns affected HGV Movements in your road?

Almost unanimous no (98%). Minority have seen more movement over lockdown periods.

Question 5 – How satisfied are you with the enforcement of any existing restrictions?

Almost unanimous not satisfied (98%). Only enforcement mentioned is speed limits and speed wardens, but these have proved unsatisfactory.

Question 6 – What measures would you like to see to improve residential streets?



'Weight Restrictions' and 'Movement Restrictions' were the top measures that respondents would like to see for improvement.
