YOUR DITCH

YOUR LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY

Horne Parish Council would like to remind residents that it is the legal responsibility of the Riparian Owner / landowner to maintain the ditches which border their property. This includes the maintenance of the banks and beds in your section of watercourse, to avoid any obstruction of flow in the watercourse.

The most common problems are:

- Failing to keep vegetation growth under control - including hedges!
- Failing to obtain consent for installing pipes or "culverting" of a watercourse. If you want to put in a pipe or culvert you must obtain permission from Surrey County Council.
- Disposal or storage of garden or domestic rubbish, waste etc. on the banks of watercourses

Horne Parish is a low-lying Parish which more recently floods in certain areas in wet weather. The effective maintenance of ditches is a very important factor in ensuring that rain water is able to be removed properly, thereby preventing flooding upstream.

Please take responsibility for your ditches!!



REPORT IT

Please report any problems you notice in your Parish regarding Pot Holes, Flytipping and Graffiti.

IF PROBLEMS ARE NOT REPORTED, THEY CAN NOT BE DEALT WITH.

The app is very easy as it guides you through a few quick steps; but basically taking a photo of the problem and its brief description.

The app automatically picks up your location and it sends the details to the correct local authority.
