Horne Parish Update

Croydon Barn Lane

Surrey County Council have listed Croydon Barn Lane in Horne on their works schedule. They have set up a Temporary Traffic Order which is required to enable highway resurfacing, maintenance and/or improvement works on behalf of Surrey County Council. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible within the eighteen month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commenced on 15 February 2019. All vehicular traffic will be diverted via Church Road, Whitewood Lane, Byers Lane, Eastbourne Road, West Park Road and Bones Lane.

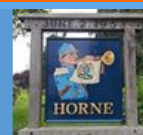

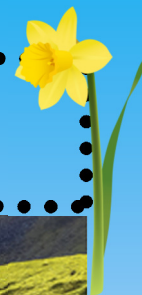

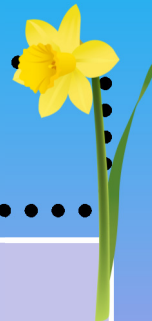
