If you have any concerns over individuals safety or health, please contact either their family or the relevant authority.

Top Tip Winter Checklist!

- Clean out gutters and repair roof leaks.
- Have your heating system serviced professionally to make sure that it is clean, working properly, and ventilated
 to the outside.
- Install a CO detector to alert you of the presence of the deadly, odourless, colourless gas
- Prepare a winter emergency kit to keep in your car in case you become stranded. The kit should include a firstaid kit; torch; mobile phone, portable charger, blankets, food and water, tyre pump, and a bag of sand or cat litter (for traction).
- Avoid traveling when the weather service has issued advisories.

REPORT IT

Please make use of a new smart phone App for Flytipping, Pot Holes and Graffiti

The app is very easy as it guides you through a few quick steps; but basically taking a photo of the rubbish and its brief description. The app automatically picks up your location and it sends the details to the correct local authority.

Proposed Garden Village

The Local Plan: Garden Villages Consultation took place from Monday 14 August to 5pm on Monday 9 October. This consultation was an opportunity for residents and other stakeholders to have their say on the location of a garden village development which forms part of the preferred strategy the Council is pursuing in preparing the Local Plan.

The locations the Council are considering are:

- Blindley Heath
- Redhill Aerodrome
- South Godstone

Tandridge District Council are no longer considering the land at Edenbridge or Land west of Edenbridge, which would cross the boarder into Seveonoaks. This is because the proposal does not form part of Sevenoaks District Council's emerging development strategy.

The Council will now consider the comments submitted to the consultation and utilise them in preparing the next iteration of the Local Plan. The next iteration of the Local Plan is intended to be one which has the content and form of the document to be submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for independent examination.

However, prior to the submission a further public consultation will take place in 2018, allowing individuals and interested parties to once again make comment on the document.

Horne Parish Council have the view that a Garden Village is not necessary for Tandridge.
