Parish Update

Bones Lane

Horne Parish Council and local residents, with the assistance of our County Councillor Lesley Steeds and our District Councillor Kevin Bourne, have been tirelessly working to ensure Bones Lane is continually being reviewed, monitored and a priority to Surrey Highways.

Surrey Highways have carried out some surface and drainage works so far. The Parish Council along with the support of our District and County Councillors will continue pushing the matter to get the situation improved.

Horne and Newchapel Cricket Ground

The Parish Council have been working with Lingfield Cricket Club (who use the ground at Newchapel) to begin the process of improving the facilities. The proposed idea is to modernise the building and offer a community centre open to the residents of Horne and the surrounding areas. Also to improve the cricket facilities so Lingfield Cricket Club can partake in more leagues utilising the grounds and facilities to the full potential

Newchapel Village Hall

Newchapel Village Hall was sold a while ago now, however Horne Parish Council has been keen to ascertain the proceeds of sale have and will be used in accordance with the Trust Deed.

The Parish Council gained an opinion from a QC who is an expert in ecclesiastical matters.

At the current time, the Parochial Church Council have not given the Parish Council the assurances sought. However Horne Parish Council will continue to seek confirmation that the funds will be used for the appropriate investments in the parish.

DITCHES - YOUR LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY

Residents need to take responsibility for ditches and hedges on their properties. The effective maintenance of ditches is a very important factor in ensuring that rain water is able to be removed properly, thereby preventing flooding upstream.

Horne Parish is a low-lying Parish which has a history of flooding in prolonged wet weather. It is the legal responsibility of the landowner to maintain the ditches which border their property, including the maintenance of the bank and bed of your section of watercourse, in order to avoid any obstruction of flow in the watercourse.

PLEASE DON'T THROW GARDEN WASTE INTO DITCHES, STREAMS OR ANY WATERCOURSE

Top Tip Winter Checklist!

- Clean out gutters and repair roof leaks.
- Have your heating system serviced professionally to make sure that it is clean, working properly, and ventilated to the outside.
- Install a CO detector to alert you of the presence of the deadly, odourless, colourless gas
- Prepare a winter emergency kit to keep in your car in case you become stranded. The kit should include a first-aid kit; torch; mobile phone, portable charger, blankets, food and water, tyre pump, and a bag of sand or cat litter (for traction).
- Avoid traveling when the weather service has issued advisories.
